The eye-catching geometric form hosts up to six guests in the closed yellow wing of the structure. On warm nights, visitors can move to the opposite side of the project where an open zigzag grid of netting sets the ideal atmosphere for gazing at the stars.





LE NUAGE

Since 2010, this abstracted cloud formation has been host to willing guests who crave mystery and outdoor adventure just next door to a unique urban experience. Allowing guests the opportunity to fall asleep with the sound of frogs and wake up with the song of birds, the graphic cloud shelters from the elements, summoning the myth of the hut and stimulating the imagination and its associated child-hood memories. Referencing the bold imagery found in utopic architecture and radical design of the 1960s and 1970s, the playfully kitsch caravan provides seven sleeping spaces with minimalistic furniture. Safe within the cloud, the striking form encourages a deeper connection to the remarkable natural setting.
